1. LP Recording. **THE ART OF MARIA CALLAS**. Angel Stereo SB 3696. Boxed set with two discs. In apparently original unopened shrink-wrap, thus Mint in a Mint box. \$35.00
2. LP Recording. **BACH: THE WELL-TEMPERED KLAVIER, BOOK I (PRELUDES AND FUGUES 1-8)**. Glenn Gould. Columbia Stereo MS 6408, 1963. Near Mint with light spindle evidence and bright, unmarked surface. Album cover shows light rubbing to front side, else Near Mint. \$20.00
3. LP Recording. **BEETHOVEN - VIOLIN CONCERTO**. Milstein, with Leinsdorf and The Philharmonia Orchestra. Angel 35783. Near Mint with very minimal spindle evidence and bright unmarked surface. Album in excellent condition. \$6.50
4. LP Recording. **BERLIOZ - ROMEO AND JULIET**. Munch, Boston Symphony Orchestra. RCA Victor LM-6011. Boxed set with two disks and program booklet. Near mint with very light spindle evidence, and with disks bright and unmarked. Box in excellent condition. \$15.00
5. LP Recording. **BRAHMS - VIOLIN CONCERTO**. Oistrackh with Klemperer and the French National Radio Orchestra. Angel 35836. Near Mint with light spindle evidence and surface bright and unmarked. Album in Excellent condition. \$10.00
6. LP Recording. **BRAHMS: THE THREE TRIOS; SCHUMANN: TRIO IN D MINOR**. RCA Victor Red Seal ARL 3-0138. Boxed set with three disks. Near mint with vitually no spindle wear; surfaces bright and unmarked. \$25.00
7. LP Recording. **CHOPIN - 3 POLONAISES, 8 MAZURKAS**. Witold Malcuzyński, piano. Angel 35284. Near Mint with light spindle evidence and bright unmarked surface. Cover in excellent condition. With Sam Goody sticker showing a list price of \$4.98. \$10.00
8. LP Recording. **DIETRICH FISCHER-DIESKAU SINGT LIEDER VON HUGO WOLF**. Gerald Moore, Piano. EMI Electrola 1C 181-01 470. Boxed set with seven disks and brochure. Ex Library, with markings on some of the disk labels. Disks Near Mint with light spindle evidence and bright unmarked surfaces. Box shows wear, including loss of part of the paste-on portrait of Fischer-Dieskau on the front cover. Brochure shows wear and has a tape repair. A very rare set. \$100.00
9. LP Recording. **EIN HELDENLEBEN - RICHARD STRAUSS - DORATI AND MINNEAPOLIS SYMPHONY**. Mercury Olympian Series MG50012, c. 1950. Near Fine with minimal spindle use and surfaces bright and unmarked. Cover shows some soiling and a 1 1/2 inch break along the bottom edge. Two Sam Goody stickers on cover, verso. \$12.00
10. LP Recording. **A GALA PERFORMANCE OF DIE FLEDERMAUS**. Von Karajan, Vienna

- Philharmonic, Gueden, Koth, Resnik, Zampieri, Kmentt, Berry, Wachter, and Kunz, plus many guest stars. London 1962. OSA 1319 (OS 25222--OS 25224). Boxed set of three disks plus program notes and libretto. Near mint with some spindle evidence and with the surfaces bright and unmarked. The album, covered in gold-stamped red moire silk, shows light wear. \$12.50
11. LP Recording. **HANDEL - CONCERTI GROSSI OP.3; CONCERTO GROSSO C-DUR, ALEXANDERFEST.** Archiv Produktion SAMP 198017-8. Boxed set with two disks and brochure. Near Mint with very minimal spindle evidence, and with surfaces bright and unmarked. Cloth covered box with a few spots of soiling, else Near Mint. Rare. \$50.00
 12. LP Recording. **JOSQUIN DES PRES - MISSA PANGE LINGUA - MOTETS AND INSTRUMENTAL PIECES.** New York Pro Musica, Noah Greenberg, Conductor. Decca DL 9410 (Gold Label Series), circa 1958-1960. Near Mint with light spindle evidence, and with the surface bright and unmarked. \$10.00
 13. LP Recording. **LE MUSICHE DI JACOPO PERI - L'EURIDICE and MARIA MEDICI.** Amadeo Arcophon AVRS 5003/3. Boxed set with two disks and brochure/libretto. Near Mint with light spindle evidence and surfaces bright and unmarked. The tray box, with cloth edges and a paper pastedown label is also Near Mint. \$25.00
 14. LP Recording. **LUDWIG OU LE CREPUSCULE DES DIEUX (LUDWIG OF BAVARIA FILM SOUNDTRACK).** Philips, 6323 022, 1972. Mostly music of Wagner, conducted by Franco Mannino. French edition, with jacket notes in French. Near Fine with minimal evidence of spindle use. Jacket Near Fine. \$15.00
 15. LP Recording. **MAHLER - SINFONIE NR. 5; ADAGIO (SINFONIE NR. 10).** Haitinck and Certcertgebow Orchestra, Amsterdam. Philips 6500 256. Boxed set with two disks and program booklet. Near Mint with very minimal spindle evidence and bright, unmarked surfaces. Box in excellent condition but for a small patch of pressure sticker damage near the outer edge, top right. \$20.00
 16. LP Recording. **THE MOST HAPPY FELLA by FRANK LOESSER.** Columbia Masterworks OL 5118. In Near Fine condition with light evidence of spindle use. Jacket Very Good, with small abrasion from sticker. \$5.00
 17. LP Recording. **MOUSSORGSKY - BORIS GODUNOV.** Boris Christoff et al, Dobrowen with Orchestre National de la Radiodiffusion Francaise. Capitol GDR 7164. Boxed set with four disks and laid in libretto. Near Mint with light spindle evidence; surfaces bright and unmarked. Box in excellent condition. \$15.00
 18. LP Recording. Moussorgsky, Modeste. **BORIS GODOUNOFF.** RCA Victor/His Master's Voice, LHMV 6400. Boxed set of four LPs, with libretto, 1952. Dobroven, conducting, with Boris Christoff, Nicolai Gedda, et al. Library stamps and labels, else in Near Mint condition, with records apparently unplayed. \$25.00
 19. LP Recording. **MOZART - THE PIANO QUARTETS (K.478 AND K.493).** Horszowski and

- Budapest String Quartet. Columbia Stereo MS 6683. Near Mint with very light spindle evidence and bright unmarked surface. \$10.00
20. LP Recording. Mozart, Wolfgang Amadeus. **COS FAN TUTTE**. Angel 3522 C/L, 1954. Von Karajan, with Schwartzkopf, Simoneau, et al. Boxed three disc set, with booklet. Near Mint (Fine or Excellent) throughout. \$20.00
21. LP Recording. **THE MUSIC MAN - ORIGINAL BROADWAY CAST**. Capitol Records WAO 990, 1957. Near Fine (very light spindle evidence, surface bright and unmarked), in original inner sleeve and a Near Fine album. With a Same Goody price sticker showing a list price of \$5.98 and a Goody price of \$4.40. \$12.50
In 1957, the show became a hit on Broadway, winning five Tony Awards, including Best Musical, and running for 1,375 performances. This cast album won the first Grammy Award for "Best Original Cast Album" and was number one on the Billboard charts for 245 weeks.
22. LP Recording. **OCTOPUSSY - ORIGINAL MOTION PICTURE SOUNDTRACK**. MGM 7502-14967-1, 1983. Record Near Mint with light spindle evidence and with the surface bright and unmarked. Remainder nick in cover at top. \$12.50
23. LP Recording. **PROKOFIEV - SYMPHONY NO. 5**. Thomas Schippers and the Philharmonia Orchestra. Angel S 35527, 1957. Near Mint with light spindle evidence and bright unmarked surface. Album in excellent condition. \$25.00
24. LP Recording. Purcell, Henry. **DIDO AND AENEAS**. RCA Victor, LHMV 1007. Boxed set including one LP record and libretto, 1952. Geraint Jones and the Mermaid Theater Company, with Elizabeth Schwatzkopf. Top of box separated, small loss at the bottom of the spine, else in excellent condition, with the record apparently unplayed. \$15.00
25. LP Recording. **Rimsky-Korsakov - SADKO**. Melodia M10 46785 006 (1985 LP issue of 1946-47 78 rpm recording). Boxed set of 3 disks, all Near Mint, possibly unplayed, plus brochure. Box shows some wear, but still Very Good. Rare. \$25.00
26. LP Recording. **THE RISE AND FALL OF THE CITY OF MAHAGONNY** by Kurt Weill and Bertolt Brecht. Columbia Masterworks K3L 243. German cast recording, 1958. With Lotte Lenya et al. Boxed set of three LPs, all in excellent condition, booklet with a fold and some foxing, box separated at hinge, else in very good condition. \$20.00
27. LP Recording. **Rossini - LA CENERENTOLA**, with Berganza, Monti, et al, Rossi conducting. Movimento Musica 03.004. 1981 issue of 1958 recording. Boxed set with three disks and brochure. Near Mint to Mint (appears unplayed) in Near Mint box. \$15.00
28. LP Recording. **ROSSINI - VIER SONATED FUR STREICHER Nr 1-4**. Scimone and I Solisti Veneti. RCA/Erato ZL 30601, German pressing, 1978. Grand Prix du Disque winner. Near Mint in Near Mint album with a small break (less than one inch) along top edge. Barely discernable spindle evidence on one side only, bright unmarked surface. \$12.50

29. LP Recording. **SHOSTAKOVICH SIXTH SYMPHONY - PROKOFIEV SCYTHIAN SUITE**. Bernstein and NY Philharmonic Orchestra. Columbia MS 7221, 1969. Stereo recording. Near Mint with very light spindle evidence, bright unmarked surface, original inner sleeve, Near Mint album cover. \$15.00
30. LP Recording. **STRAUSS - DER ROSENKAVALIER**. Bohm, Saxon State Orchstra, Schech, Seefried, Streich, Fischer-Dieskau, Bohme. Deutsche Grammophon DGM 12031-4, 1958. Boxed set with four disks and brochure. Near Mint with light spindle evidence and bright, unmarked surfaces throughout. Box has a few surface abrasions on the front cover, else Very Good. \$35.00
31. LP Recording. **A TRIBUTE TO GERALD MOORE**. Angel S-36640, 1970. Near Fine with minimal spindle use and surfaces clear and bright. Jacket Near Fine, booklet present. \$12.00
32. LP Recording. **TRIOS FUR FLOTE, VIOLONCELLO UND KLAVIER - WEBER TRIO IN G-MOLL. OPUS 63, AND MARTINU TRIO**. Christophorus CGLP 75715. Mint (unplayed, but opened) in very good album. Scarce. \$25.00
33. LP Recording. **TSCHAIKOWSKY - WETTBEWERB MOSKAU 1966 (Tschaikowsky Competition)**. Piano Concerto played by Grigorij Sokolow; Violin Concerto played by Victor Tretjakow. Parnass Stereo 75999, 1966. Two record set. Opened, but Mint, with no evidence of spindle contact, and with the surface bright and unmarked. \$15.00
34. LP Recording. Verdi, Giuseppe. **I DUE FOSCARI**. Philips, 1977. Boxed set with two discs and booklet. Cardelli and ORF Symphony, with Ricciarelli, Carreras, Capucilli and Ramey. Fine. \$15.00
35. LP Recording. Verdi, Giuseppe. **UN GIORNO DI REGNO (KING FOR A DAY)**. Philips 6703 055 {3LPS} (1974). Boxed set of three LP discs plus booklet. Billed as the first complete recording, and the first in stereo. Conducted by Lamberto Gardelli, and starring Jessye Norman and Jose Carreras. In excellent condition. Uncommon. \$25.00
36. LP Recording. **WAGNER - DAS RHEINGOLD**. Solti, Vienna Philharmonic, Flagstad, London, et al. London, OSA 1309 A4340. Boxed set with three disks, program and libretto booklet. Near Mint with light spindle evidence, surfaces bright and unmarked. \$20.00
